What is Camp Keepsake?

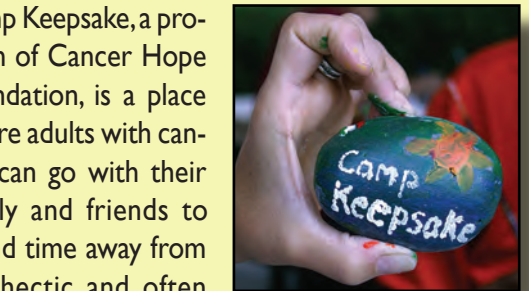
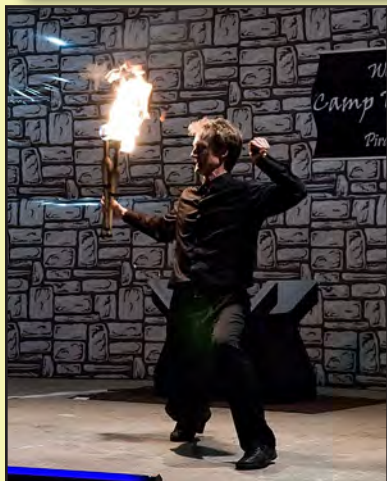

Depending in part on our level of response, a portion or all of our applicants may also be considered on a first come/first served basis; consequently, available openings may be filled prior to our application deadline which is subject to change. Our selection committee reserves the right to add or hold open spaces for late(r) applicants as deemed appropriate. Interested patients and those in remission are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Please note that submitting an application does not ensure an invitation. Invitations to attend camp are given at the sole discretion of the selection committee. Depending on our level of response, a wait list may also be initiated.
